# ABOUT THE ACADEMY

Our goal is to create a fun atmosphere where kids will be engaged and motivated to improve their game. Our weekly curriculum will include instruction focused on the fundamentals of golf, and age/experience-based pairings while playing on course. The FGA will be divided into individual 5 instructional days and 5 on-course play day sessions, along with our season ending session consisting of a Fun Day on the driving range and putting green.

# PLAYING FORMAT

The FGA play days are formatted to help young players see success by applying the skills they have learned from the instructional clinics to their on-course round. Placing players by age/ability level will allow them to make friends and play with others that have similar abilities and make for a more enjoyable golf experience. During the course setup each week, the yardage and weekly game will allow them to apply their skills developed from the lesson to on course play.
